The Case Challenge

A national trucking company faced a personal injury claim following a rear-end collision involving an 18-wheeler. The plaintiff was a front-seat passenger in a vehicle when it was struck from behind. The impact with the 18-wheeler caused the passenger vehicle to veer into another lane and collide with a third unit. The plaintiff was transported to a medical facility with complaints of neck and back pain, later reporting headaches, cervical spine pain, thoracic pain, and lumbar spine pain.

The plaintiff's medical records revealed a longstanding history of migraines and headaches. Among other key tasks, the defense team needed to evaluate the neurological complaints and determine whether they were causally related to the accident or preexisting.
